We are a not-for-profit senior services organization focused on emphasizing our guiding principles of *aloha* (love, compassion), *mālama* (caring), *laulima* (cooperation), *hō‘ihi* (respect), *ho‘omanawanui* (patience), *loko maika‘i* (generosity) and *pono* (doing what is right) in all that we do. We seek diligent professionals who embrace these values to celebrate, perpetuate and advance the legacy of King Lunalilo to broader reaches and to greater impacts in our communities.

We seek a **Utility Worker** for on call schedules (flexible for day, evening, night shifts).

PURPOSE:

To provide for an overall quality of care to the residents in a safe and pleasant environment – “Caring with Aloha”. Demonstrating to all *kūpuna*, families, guests and staff at Lunalilo Home through verbal communication and physical action, the meaning of “Aloha” – caring with respect and kindness.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Dietary:

- Performs variety of tasks in the kitchen and dining room. Tasks include sweeping and mopping floors, keeping cold and dry storage clean, cleaning ranges, food carts, and other food service equipment. Works in dishwashing area and transports food to clients.
- Portions food and does simple food preparation tasks.
- Opportunity to be cross-trained as relief cook.

Housekeeping:

- Cleans rooms, bedrooms, bathrooms and other residential areas.
- Cleans offices, staff lounges, patios and lanais.
- Cleans other equipment used by residents like wheelchairs, fans, etc.

Laundry:

- Washes and dries residents clothing and linens.
- Folds and delivers clothing and linens to proper locations.
- Sanitizes laundry equipment and keeps laundry area clean and orderly.

Overall:

- Please be energetic and enthusiastic with good organization skills.
- Must be able to follow simple directions and procedures.

- Must be able to understand basic health and sanitation principles.
- Must be able to work a flexible schedule, including Saturdays and Sundays.
- Valid Hawaii Driver's License and clean driving abstract is a plus.

REQUIREMENTS AND REQUIRED LICENSES/CERTIFICATIONS:

2 step TB clearance and annual clearance thereafter.

(optional) Driver's license.

Must meet I-9 employment eligibility requirements.

EDUCATION:

High School diploma, G.E.D. or equivalent. Ability to read, write, speak and communicate effectively in English.

EXPERIENCE:

Cleaning experience in a health care setting is preferred.
